TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The following persons are NOT eligible to receive an Award; employees of The Toronto-Dominion Bank and its subsidiaries ("TD"); the children of TD employees and Program applicants ("Applicants") who provide false information to TD at any time.
2. To be eligible for a Award, Applicants must:
 - a) Be in their final year of high school or first year of post-secondary education
 - b) Be a Canadian citizen or have permanent resident status & be a resident of Ontario
 - c) Certify that all the information provided on the Program application form ("Application") and in all the accompanying documents is true, accurate and complete to the best of their knowledge and
 - d) Who are attending a Post-Secondary Educational Institution in the Province of Ontario; **who are completing their FIRST post-secondary program of study;** and who are transgender or transsexual.
 - e) By submitting an Application, the Applicant authorizes TD, the Award judges, and their respective representatives to collect, use, store and confirm information about the Applicant, provided on the Application submitted (including references) to those who need to know such information for the purposes of administering and promoting the Program. The selection committee will use the information only for the purposes of evaluating the Application.
3. An Award awarded under the Program can be held at any college or university in Canada approved by TD ("Approved School"). The Award recipient ("Recipient") is responsible for securing admission to an Approved School of their choice, in accordance with the requirements and deadlines of each school.
4. The 2011 TD Trans Youth Scholarship Award will have a value of no more than two thousand five hundred (\$2500) Canadian Dollars
5. A Recipient must:
 - a) attend an Approved School on a part-time or full-time basis (as defined by the school),
 - b) be enrolled in a course of study leading to a first degree/diploma; and
 - c) pass all courses.Recipients may change disciplines, programs and/or Approved Schools during the Award term. Grades or marks obtained in supplementary or repeated examinations in the same academic year (including summer sessions) will be considered in extenuating circumstances. Recipients may defer enrollment in an Approved School for up to one year, or they may interrupt their studies for up to one year, on one occasion only, at the successful conclusion of an academic year. Reinstatement of the Award will be conditional on reacceptance at an Approved School. Recipient who fail to return to school after one year deferment or who drop out of school will forfeit the Award.
6. All Recipients must inform themselves as to the tax consequences of receiving the Award.
7. All Recipients will be required to sign a Declaration and Release which will entitle TD to use the Recipient's name, city and province of residence, and photograph, without further compensation for any publicity carried out by TD with respect to the Program.
